VINEYARD NOTES

The cade Napa Cuvee Cabernet Sauvignon is a Napa Valley Appellation designated wine. Made from some of Napa's most renowned vineyards: Beckstoffer's George the 3rd Vineyard in Rutherford, Beckstoffer's Orchard Avenue Vineyard in Oak Knoll, Kenefick Ranch Vineyards in Calistoga, and Dr. Crane Vineyards in St. Helena

ÉLEVAGE

The wine received 19 months barrel aging in 100% French Oak (70% New). For the first six months we performed bâtonnage (lees stirring) bi-monthly and the wine was racked quarterly.

Inviting aromas of black currant, black olive, blackberries, and acacia. On the palate, flavors of dark chocolate, soy, black currant, and star anise are followed by wonderful mouth coating tannins that are very plush and long.
