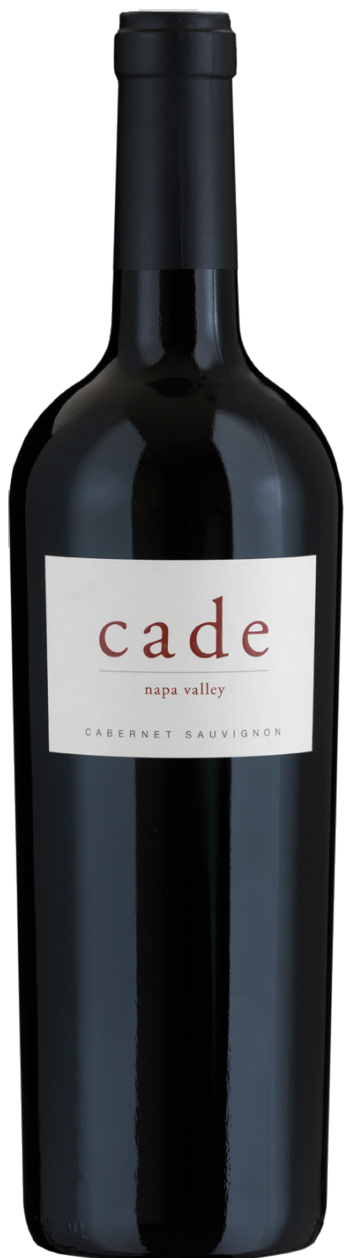




## 2019 cade CABERNET SAUVIGNON, NAPA VALLEY



### VINTAGE

The cade napa valley Cabernet Sauvignon is made from two of Napa's most renowned vineyards: Kenefick Ranch Vineyards in Calistoga and Hanson-Hsieh Vineyard in Oak Knoll. We picked the fruit from these vineyards starting on September 25th until October 15th, 2019.

### ÉLEVAGE

The wine received 18 months barrel aging in 100% French Oak (58% New). Malolactic fermentation occurred in barrel immediately after primary fermentation. The wine was racked quarterly once malolactic fermentation was complete.

### COOPERAGE

We use several different coopers for the Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon including Allary, Atelier, Tonnellerie O, Nadalie, Taransaud, Quintessence, Saint Martin, and Mercier. Of these coopers we are sourcing the oak from several different forests as well as using a combination of Medium and Medium Long toasting levels.

### BOTTLING

The wine was bottled on May 27th, 2021.

### WINEMAKER IMPRESSIONS

The wine has aromas of blackberry, black cherry, boysenberry, vanilla, clove, brown spices, white pepper, rose petal, and dark chocolate. In the palate are flavors of fresh purple fruits, chocolate covered cherries, cinnamon, and raspberry. The Petit Verdot adds a lot of structure and weight to this wine as well as some inky dark color. The velvety and lush tannins on the finish of this wine is an excellent example of what valley floor fruit has to offer.
